2006 Competition: Strings (Violin, Viola, Cello, and Double Bass)**

**PURPOSE**

To encourage and foster the development of young performing artists of Korean heritage in or from the Washington-Baltimore metropolitan area.

**AWARDS**

**First Prize:** \$2,000 Cash Award; A private recital in May 2006 in Washington, DC area

**Second Prize:** \$1,000 Cash Award

**AUDITION**

Saturday, April 29, 2006 at the Korean Cultural Center, Washington DC (**closed to public**)

**ELIGIBILITY**

Open to college level students of Korean heritage currently studying music in the Washington-Baltimore metropolitan area; OR Washington-Baltimore metropolitan area residents currently studying elsewhere. **No Age limit. Not eligible:** performers under professional management.

**RULES**

1. **Audition repertoire**

Violin One movement from an unaccompanied partita or sonata by J.S. Bach and one movement from standard concerto repertoire

Viola One movement from unaccompanied suite by J.S. Bach and one movement from standard concerto repertoire

Cello One movement from unaccompanied suite by J.S. Bach and one movement from standard concerto repertoire

Bass One movement from unaccompanied suite by J.S. Bach and one movement from standard concerto repertoire

2. **How to apply**

The application package;

(a) A typewritten résumé

(b) Non-refundable entry fee of \$30 (payable to Korean Concert Society)

(c) Copy of current student ID (for proof of student status) and/or copy of drivers license or voter registration (for proof of Washington-Baltimore area residency)

(d) 4" x 6" current color photograph of the applicant

(e) Self-addressed and stamped envelope
